Looking to bring a sporting event to Nanaimo or grow one you're already running? There are a number of grants available at the local, provincial, and national level that can help with costs like travel, facility rental, marketing, and event operations.

We've rounded up some of the key programs below.

Local Support - What does this look like?

Tourism Nanaimo Grants

Tourism Nanaimo offers funding to events that attract visitors and generate overnight stays. If your sport event brings people to Nanaimo, you may be eligible for support.

Provincial Funding Opportunities (British Columbia)

Hosting BC (viaSport)

Supports provincial, national, and international sport events hosted in BC. Funding can be up to \$35,000.

Community Sport Program Development Fund (viaSport)

Helps communities increase participation in sport, with a focus on underrepresented groups.

For larger-scale national and international competitions. Funding generally ranges from \$25,000–\$150,000.
